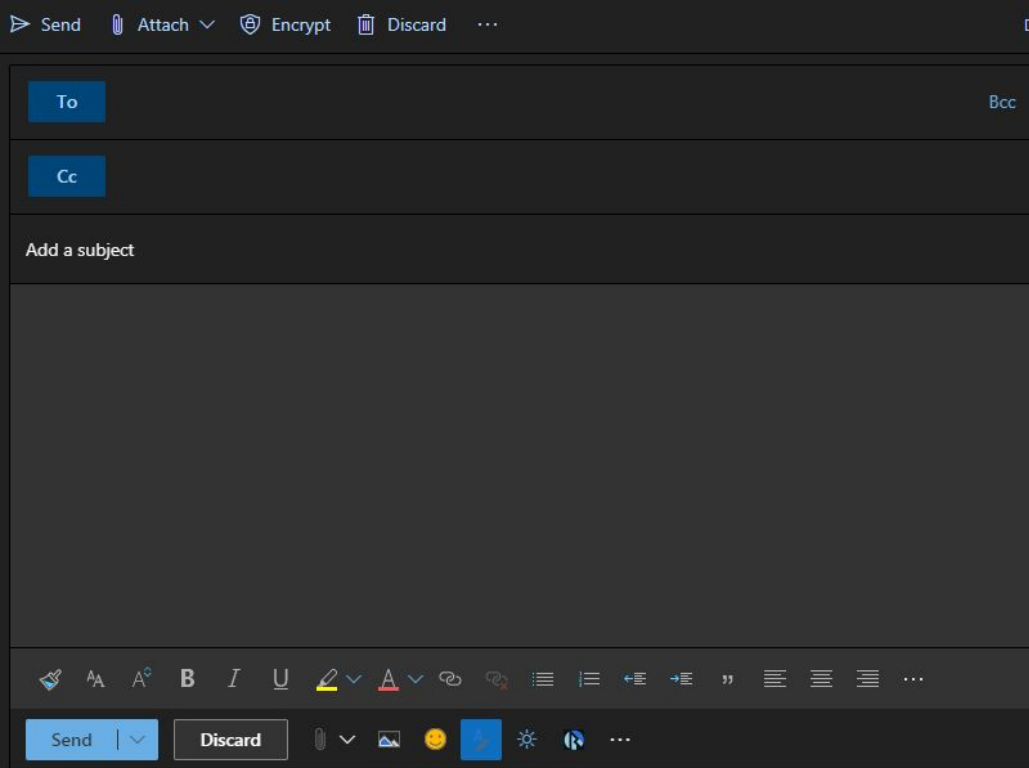
# Installation

## Prerequisites:

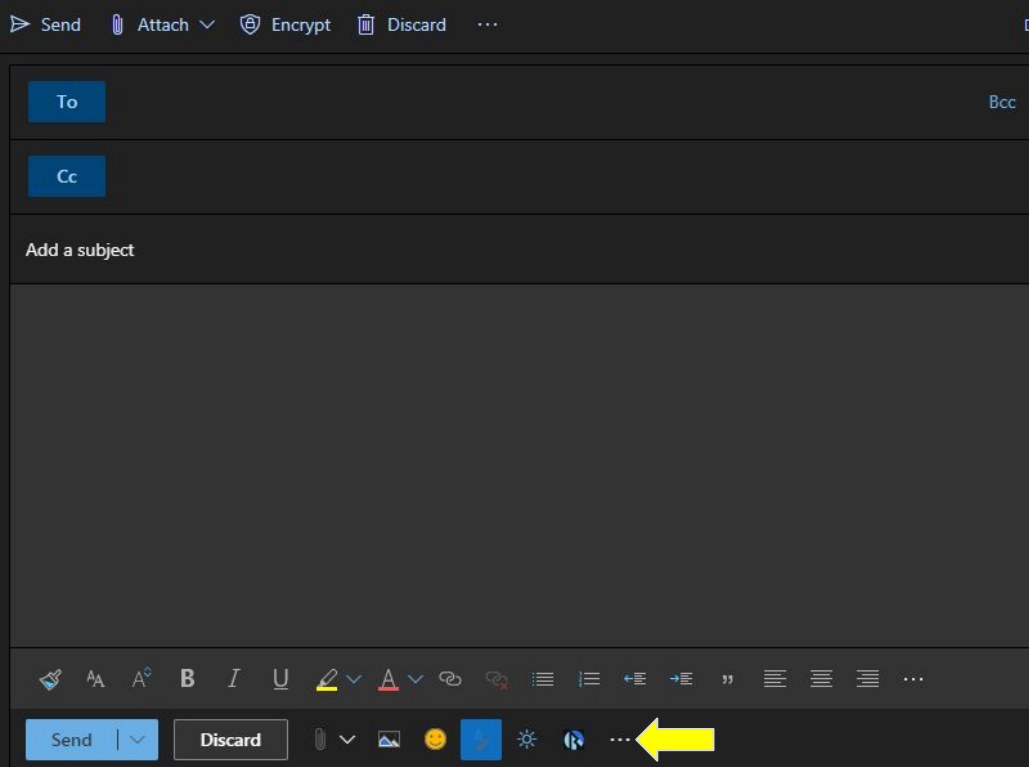
- 1) If on Windows, make sure [Webview2](#) is installed (if you have an older OS version)

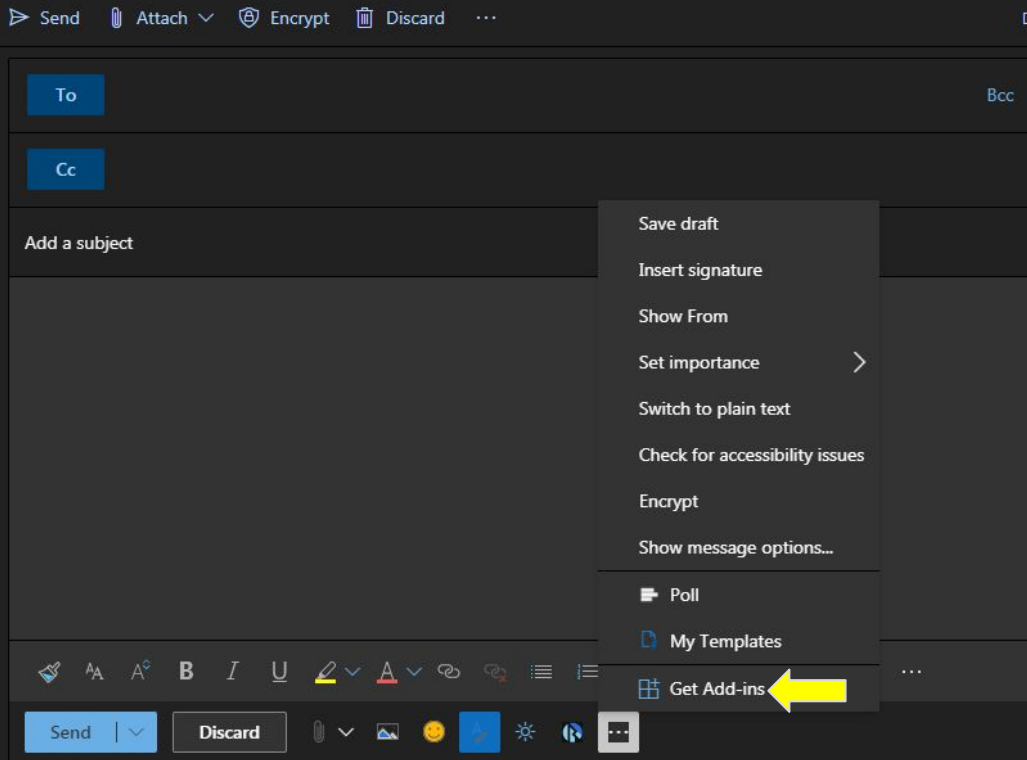

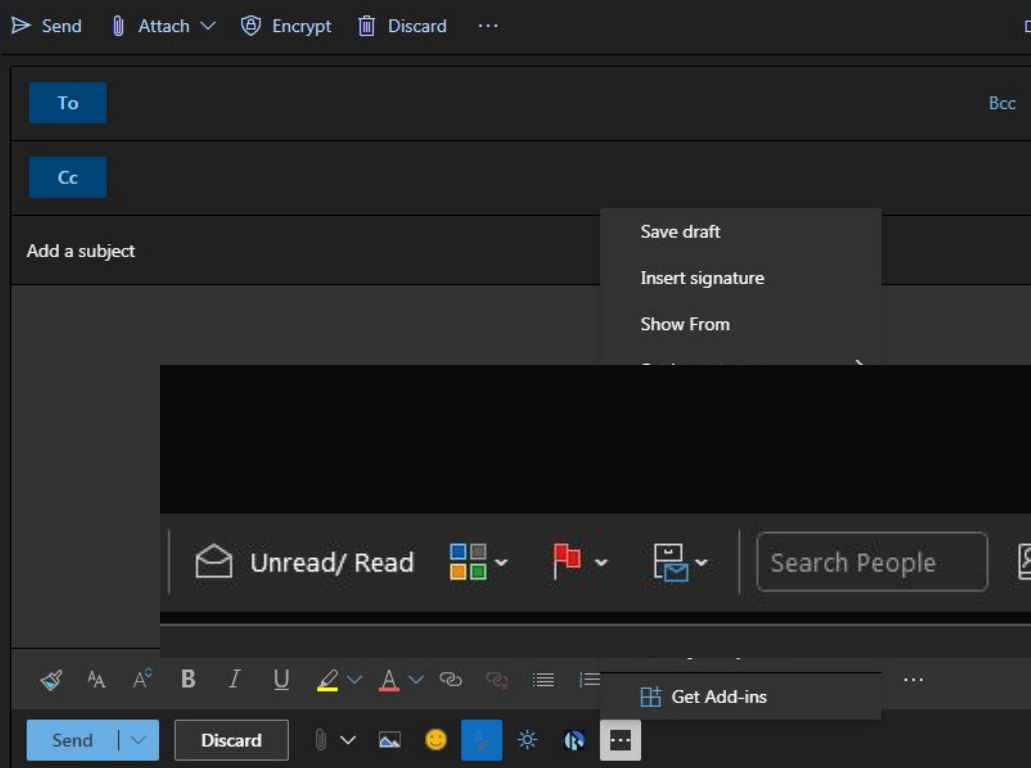

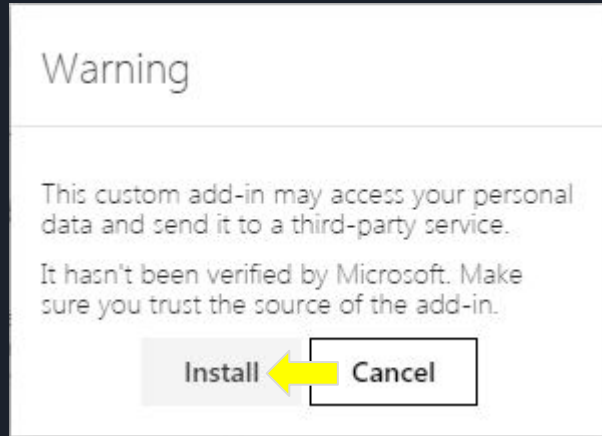

# Installing Kurer for Outlook



1. Start composing a new email

9. Click install

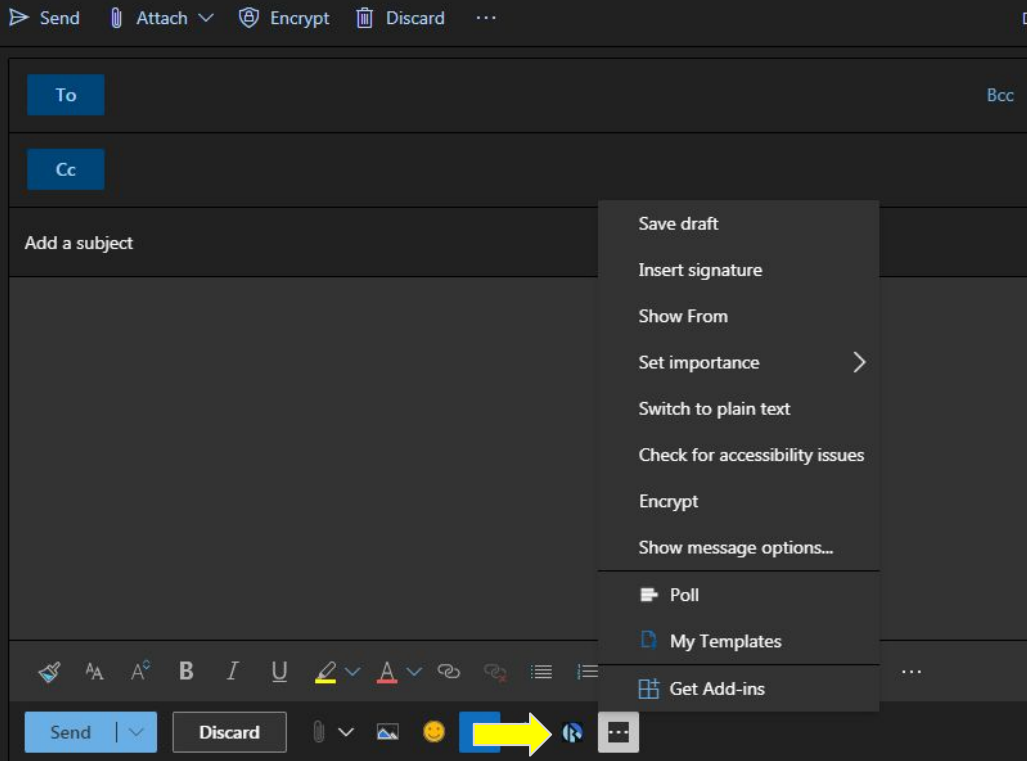


Congrats!

# Using Kurer for Outlook



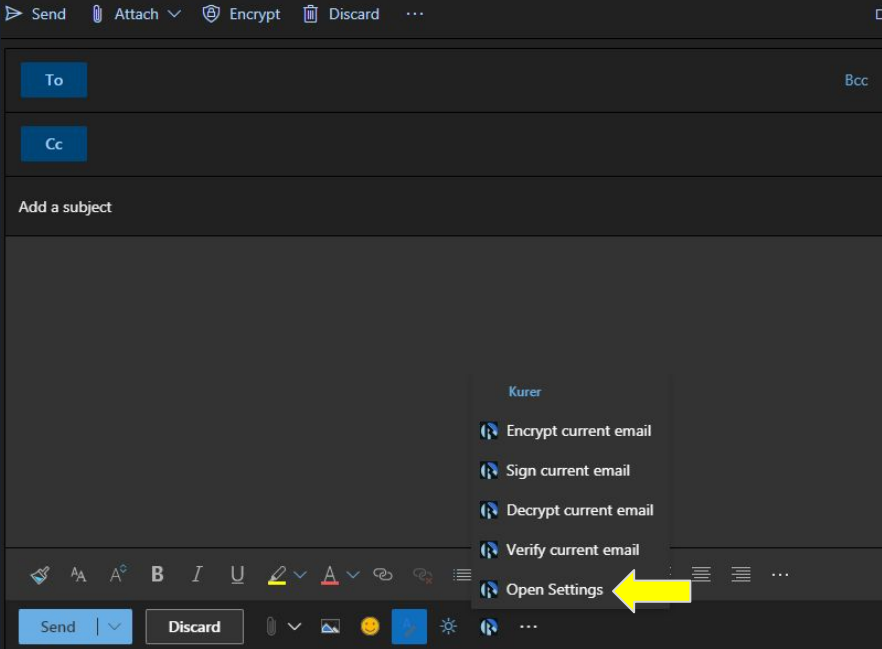
You should now find a Kurer button either:

- Pinned somewhere on your compose email pane (as in the image)

OR

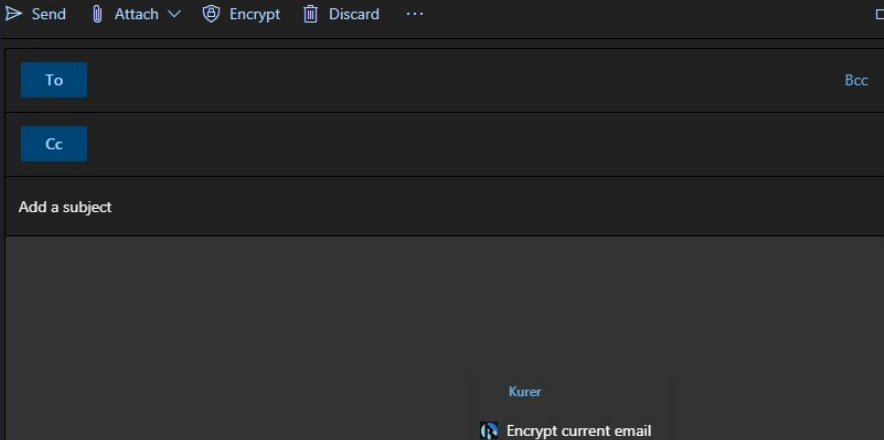
- Somewhere in the three dots list with the name “Kurer”

# Using Kurer for Outlook



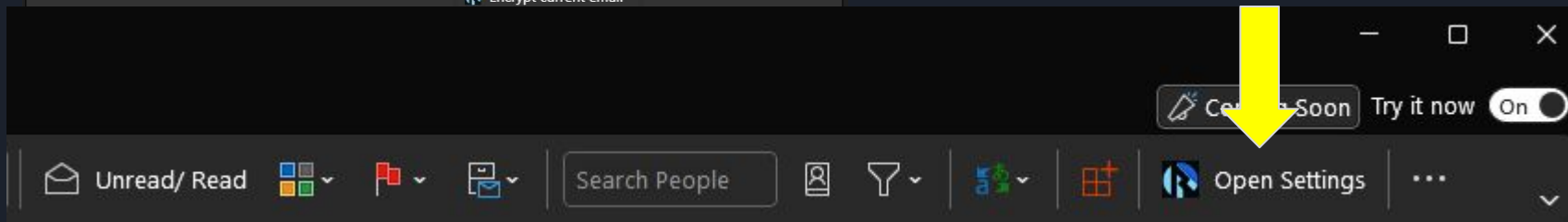
- Click the “Open Settings” button
- This is also where you’ll be able to find the buttons to manually encrypt/sign emails you are composing

# Using Kurer for Outlook



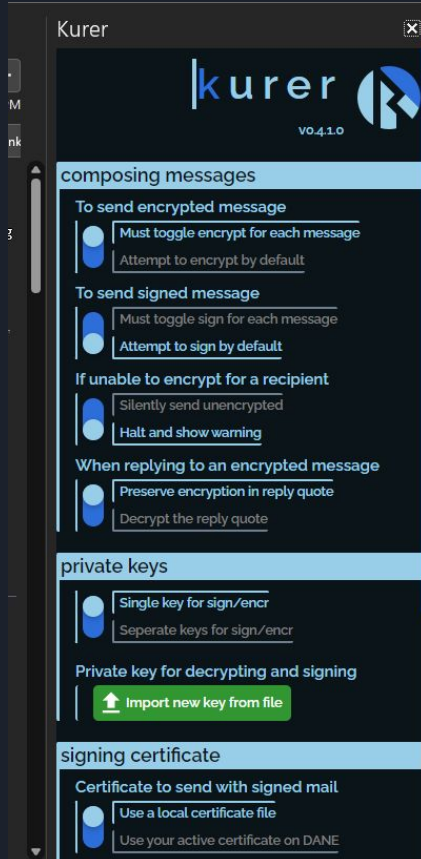
- Click the “Open Settings” button

*Once again, client versions of Outlook may have the button on the top bar after selecting any email to read:*



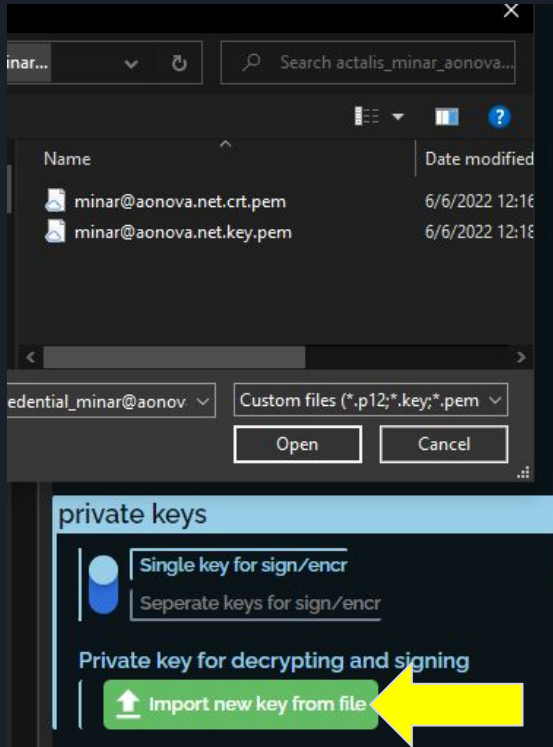

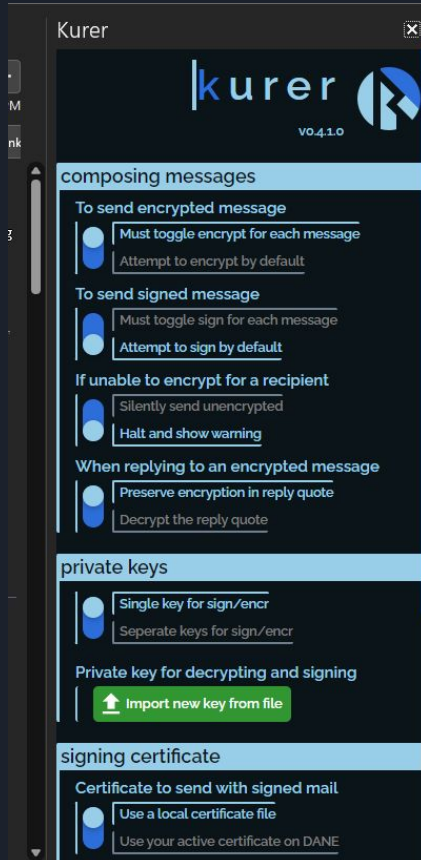
By default Kurer tries to sign every email you send.

To allow this you need to add a private key and signing certificate.

Add your key or cert file using the import button

- *Currently the most compatible format is PEM - like those generated on daneportal.net*
- Make sure to click the check button to confirm the import, and save all changes

# Using Kurer for Outlook



- Assuming your key/cert is correct you can automatically sign emails when sending!
- Toggle this behavior and others in the settings
  - *Read the tooltips for more details*
